## The "Hungarian Plates" as a concept

During the second half of the 16th Century Sweden was a major exporter of copper, just like Hungary and Germany. To facilitate the transportation of the copper it was made into large plates that were often stamped, presumably to guarantee quality and indicate the origin. The weight of these plates are usually around 20 kg, but can be approx. 15 kg to approx. 30 kg. On some of these plates the stamps have been identified as Hungarian Coat-of-Arms, hence the reference as "Hungarian Plates" which became a standard expression also for copper plates with other origins. In Sweden there was copper being processed into these plates during the years 1587–1595 – however it remains unknown what the stamps (if any) these would have.

### Begreppet "Ungerska plåtar"

*Under andra halvan av 1500-talet var Sverige, liksom bland annat Ungern och Tyskland stora kopparexportörer. För att underlätta frakten av kopparen gjöts densamma främst i rektangulära plåtar och förseddes med stämplars vars syfte troligen var att garantera kvalitet samt ursprung. Vikten på plåtarna varierar något men brukar ligga kring ca. 20 kg, men varierar från ca 15 kg upp mot 30 kg. Av undersökt material är stämplarna ofta tre till antalet, likadana eller olika. På några av dessa plåtar har stämplars kunnat identifieras som Ungerska vapensköldar, härav benämningen "Ungerska plåtar", ett begrepp som blev inarbetat och som kom att gälla plåtar även från andra länder. I Sverige förädlades koppar till Ungerska plåtar under åren 1587–1595, hur stämplarna på dessa ser ut är dock för oss okänt.*

The engraver style of the medal is similar to Stralsund's coinage 1706–1709, hence this medal is probably struck during this period. Hildebrand mentions three known gold specimens in his catalogue: Kungliga Myntkabinettet, the museum of Schwerin and De Geers collection.
